Par II. Mechanical Engineering Depth and Breadth Requirements

a) One of the courses from Part I c), d), or e) above must be completed at the Upper Division 3000 level or higher (this requirement is automatically met by the new International Requirement.)

b) Two of the courses from c), d), or e) above must form a two course sequence (where the second course builds upon the ideas of the first course).

c) One additional Upper Division course OR one additional two course sequence (repeat requirement Part II a) OR requirement Part II b)
