One graduate level scholarship may be awarded if there are an adequate number of applications from qualified individuals.

- ◆ List of classes in these areas that you have completed or are planning to take.

Please submit this application package, signed by your academic advisor (cover letter), to the Utah ASHRAE Student Activities Chair (see contact info below) via e-mail. **The deadline for receiving these applications is March 12, 2013.** The Utah ASHRAE chapter Board of Governors will review the applications and select two or three successful students to be awarded the scholarships.
